There has been much discussion here and at City Council concerning access to the courtyard and front lawn. We do have those who enjoy watching the traffic on Grant Street. It is great for them to be outdoors. Safety becomes our issue. The fence does not extend around the front lawn thus those who are wandering could reach the street or leave the property. It would be wonderful if elders could access outdoors without waiting for an activity scheduled outside or a caregiver to have adequate time to take them out.

We have solicited bids for a front awning and iron rail fencing to enclose the area. The bids included some new cement to assure a smooth walking surface. The project will hopefully begin next spring. That start date is dependant on funds being available.

The Imperial EMS considered this a worthy project and donated \$500.00 to start a fund for a porch/awning, fence, and cement. Their hope was that others would contribute likewise. The total project will be somewhere in the neighborhood of \$60,000.00. That seems incredibly large to me but hey I'm to that age where everything costs too much! Broken down to smaller increments that is only 60 one thousand dollar donations or 120 five hundred dollar donations.

The Imperial Manor / Parkview Heights is a great asset to this community. Hopefully at this time of caring and sharing many of you will see fit to make a contribution to this project.
