### Social Security stimulus checks to be sent in May

Millions of retirees and others across the country will get a piece of the economic-stimulus bill in May when the Social Security Administration plans to send a one-time \$250 payment to recipients of Social Security and Supplemental Security Income.



The payments will be sent the same way that recipients of these programs get their benefits: directed deposited in their accounts or via mail.

The money springs from the economic-stimulus bill signed into law by President Obama on Tuesday.

Obama and supporters of the bill said they wanted to make sure retirees and those unable to work were not excluded from the stimulus package. They want to send the money soon knowing in most cases it will be spent quickly and help pump up the economy.
